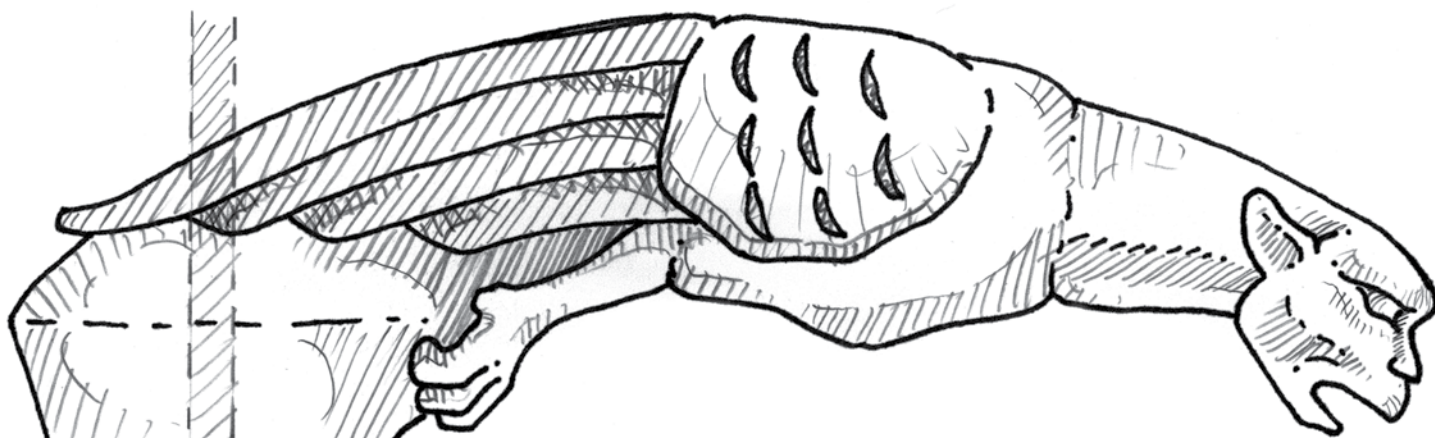
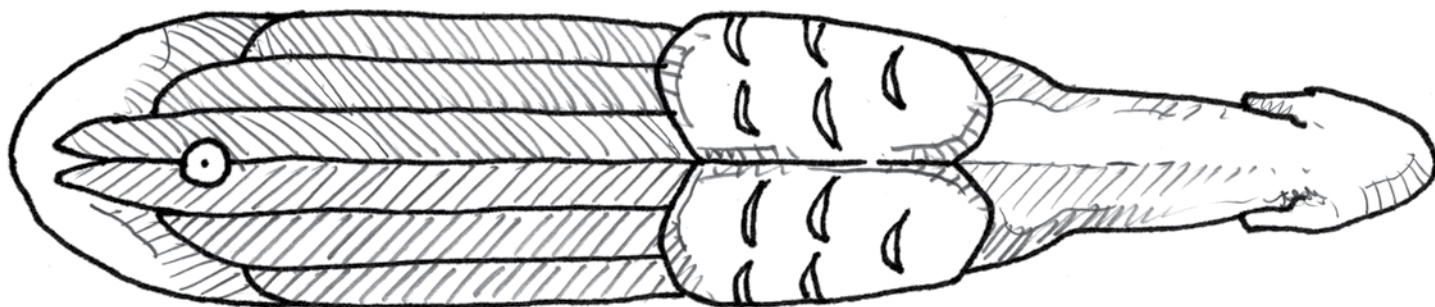

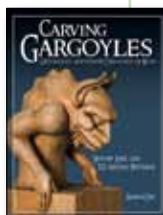

materials & tools

MATERIALS:

- 1½" (38mm) x 2½" (64mm) x 7½" (191mm) mahogany or wood of choice (handle)
- 1½" (38mm) x 1½" (38mm) x 2¾" (70mm) mahogany or wood of choice (shaft sleeve)
- 1¼" (32mm) to 1½" (38mm) x 48" (1219 mm) swamp maple or wood of choice (shaft)
- Polyurethane
- ¼" (6mm)-diameter by 8¾" (222mm)-long threaded rod
- 000 and 0000 steel wool
- Wood glue

TOOLS:

- Carving tools of choice
- Drill with a long ¼" (6mm)-diameter drill bit
